About

The National Storytelling Conference brings together National Storytelling Network (NSN) members, as well as individuals and organizations from the community, who are interested in the art and application of storytelling. Members and non-members present material appealing to attendees' interests and developmental needs.

Mission

The National Storytelling Network is a membership organization made up of individuals and organizations involved in storytelling. Its mission is to advance all forms of storytelling within the community through promotion, advocacy, and education.

Vision

A world in which all people value the power of storytelling and its ability to connect, inspire, and instill respect within our hearts and communities.

Call for Proposals

2020 brought a halt to in-person conferences and storytelling. Thanks to the creative resilience of storytellers, we responded to the sudden shut down with online performances, workshops, and conferences! Stage performers and teachers became skilled at virtual storytelling. However, most of us missed the synergy of being in person and, especially, the ability to easily converse with our peers at a conference. With that in mind, NSN invites you to join us in person (with live streaming options) so we can be together again! While community and networking are central to this theme, presentation topics are not limited by this. We look forward to all topics that instruct, build each other up, and help us navigate this new storytelling world.

The Conference Planning Committee invites you to submit proposals for consideration in the following session categories (defined within the application):

- Workshops (90 minutes)
- Panels/roundtable discussions (90 minutes)
- Intensives (3 hours)
- Presentations (90 minutes)
- Coaching (90 minutes)
- Daily early morning lawn activity (30 minutes, 3 slots)

A wide range of topics will be considered. In addition, proposals that align with specific Special Interest Groups will be identified in the program. For more information on the SIGS and discussion groups, visit our website here.

Application

We welcome proposal submissions from anyone. Presenters are not required to be members of NSN, but 80% of sessions must be presented by NSN members.

Presenter Compensation

Each presenter of a 90-minute presentation will receive \$100 off registration. Presenters of three-hour intensive receive \$150 off registration. Morning activity leader receives \$100 off registration for three 30-minute sessions.

Proposal Evaluation

Proposals will be evaluated for: quality of program, clarity of intent, practicality of process, expertise of presenter on this topic, interest to general membership or to applications of storytelling (Special Interest Groups), and diversity of presentations.

Notification

All applicants will be notified of their acceptance or rejection by e-mail sent on or before December 15, 2023.

Acceptance

All applicants receiving notification of acceptance must email their acceptance confirmation and contract to NSN by January 2, 2024—failure to respond by the deadline may result in withdrawal of the offer to present. We will also request at this time a high-quality electronic photo (300 dpi or higher) and a 30-word biography for publicity.

Session Category

Workshops: Practical, interactive learning experiences.

Presentations: Sessions on in-depth topics, innovative projects, etc.

Panels/roundtable discussions: Limit 4 presenters, including the moderator.

Coaching: Group coaching for a limited number of participants who sign up in advance.

Intensives: Practical, interactive in-depth class that requires more time than a workshop.

Early morning activity on lawn daily (exercise, meditation, dance, etc.)
