LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

On September 26, 2024, the deadliest hurricane since Katrina devastated the southeastern United States. Since that day, thousands of volunteers from states across the nation have donated their time and money to aid the recovery efforts in places hard hit like Asheville and Boone, North Carolina; Damascus, Virginia; Erwin, Jonesborough, and Elizabethton, Tennessee, including the small hamlets and communities in between and parts of Alabama, Florida, Georgia and South Carolina. The loss of life, homes and businesses has been catastrophic. Residents of Johnson City experienced some wind and rain damage resulting in damaged property, power and Internet loss, but we were unscathed in comparison. My home was not damaged, but I feel keenly the grief and sorrow of my neighbors in the surrounding towns.

Less than two weeks later, Hurricane Milton made landfall in the Tampa Bay area of Florida, adding to the damage and loss of life. Nevertheless, thanks to the outpouring of generosity from individuals, churches, volunteer organizations, including FEMA, the United Way, and state emergency aid organizations, people are rebuilding these communities one brick at a time.

While roads are opening and power and water is being restored, it will take a long time to complete restoration.

Seeing the need to step up and contribute to relief efforts, the NSN Board of Directors met to discuss what we could do to help those affected by these hurricanes. We decided our community would best be served by focusing our efforts on helping storytellers who lost their income because of these hurricanes. For that reason, we have joined forces with Artists Standing Strong Together (ASST). We have contributed matching funds to double the grant money in the Storyteller Relief Fund (SRF). While the amount is small in comparison to the need, NSN will continue to collect donations to contribute to the SRF and to aid storytellers impacted by future disasters around the nation.




